## 1. INTRODUCTION

Boxing Canada will have up to three (3) coaches supporting the National Team at the 2023 Pan American Games (PAG) and the preceding preparatory camp. Canada's two National Team coaches will fill roles at this event. A minimum of one (1) position will be assigned to a female coach.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

# **NCCP** Aspects

Coaches wishing to be considered by Boxing Canada must be:

- Competition-development 'in training' NCCP; or
- A coach who has completed at least six (6) NCCP Competition Development multisport modules;

or

• A coach who has completed at least four (4) NCCP Competition Development multisport modules and Boxing Canada's Performance Analysis Workshop.

## Administrative aspects

- A member in good standing with their provincial boxing association (PSO) and Boxing Canada.
- A current member of the professional coaching program of the Coaching Association of Canada (desirable);
- Available for the entire duration of the event (See Section 2)
- Sign the Code of Conduct;
- Complete the Safe Sport online module on the locker;
- English or French speaking. (bilingual is desirable);

# Coaching Selection Procedures 2024 Pan American Games

- Background checks and Safe Sport Training.
- Meet all COC, Panam Sport, IOC or other governing body's travel or eligibility requirements.

# International Eligibility

- Certified at least 1-star IBA, an asset but not required;
- Provide a valid Canadian passport with an expiry of at least six months from the conclusion of the event (May 10, 2024);
- Provide proof that they can meet any COVID-related restrictions in place at the time of travel booking.

#### 2. MANDATORY EVENTS COMMITMENT

The coaches selected for the team will be required to attend a training camp before the 2023 PAG, as set out below. Full participation (every training session) is required from all selected coaches unless otherwise authorized in advance by the HPD.

Here are the relevant dates and locations for the mandatory events:

- Event Training Camp: October 1st to 14th, 2023 location TBC
- Event Boxing Competition of the 2023 Santiago Pan American Games October 16 to 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023, in Santiago, Chile,

## 3. SELECTION

The HPD will review all applications in consultation with the HPAG, and the candidates who meet the requirements will be ranked and selected based on the following criteria:

- **1.** Experience as a coach with the National Team in an international competition or training camp.
- 2. Personal coach of an athlete on the National Team within the last year.
- 3. Curent NCCP certification level;
- 4. Curent IBA certification Level;

## 5. COMMUNICATION

Boxing Canada will publish the selection process for coaching staff through Boxing Canada's established channels, including but not limited to the Boxing Canada website and social media platforms.



## 6. PROCESS AND TIMELINE

Coaches have until Thursday, March 16<sup>-</sup> at 16:00 Eastern time to submit their application. On March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023<sup>-</sup> Boxing Canada will email all selected and non-selected coaches to advise them of the selection decisions. Identified coaches will have until April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023, to complete all COC personal information entry data on the COC "Bridge" portal. Coaches selected for inclusion on the COC longlist will not necessarily be selected as part of the Santiago PAG's National Team coaching staff. The final coach selection will occur by August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023.

Only coaches meeting eligibility requirements will be reviewed.

# 7. FUNDING

Travel and full board accommodation expenses associated with the participation of the precompetition camp and the competition will be covered by Boxing Canada. Please note that these positions will not be remunerated.
