1. INTRODUCTION

Boxing Canada will have up to two (2) coaches supporting the National Team at the 2023 Boxam International Tournament. One of Canada's two National Team coaches will fill a coaching role at this event. One further boxing coach will be selected from the applicants for this posting to support the national coach at this competition.

2. ELIGIBILITY

NCCP Aspects

Coaches wishing to be considered by Boxing Canada must be:

- Competition-development 'in training' NCCP;
 - or
- A coach who has completed at least six (6) NCCP Competition Development multisport modules;

or

• A coach who has completed at least four (4) NCCP Competition Development multisport modules and Boxing Canada's Performance Analysis Workshop.

Administrative aspects

- A member in good standing with their provincial boxing association (PSO) and Boxing Canada.
- A current member of the professional coaching program of the Coaching Association of Canada (desirable);
- Available for the entire duration of the event (See Section 2)
- Sign the Code of Conduct;
- Complete the Safe Sport online module on the locker;
- English or French speaking. (bilingual is desirable);
- Background checks and Safe Sport Training.

International Eligibility

- Provide a valid Canadian passport with an expiry of at least three months from the conclusion of the event (May 4, 2024);
- Provide proof that they can meet any COVID-related restrictions during travel booking.

3. MANDATORY EVENTS COMMITMENT

The coaches selected for the team will only be required to attend the Boxam competition. No further attendance at other events is required.

4. SELECTION

The HPD will review all applications in consultation with the HPAG, and the candidates who meet the requirements will be ranked and selected based on the following criteria:

- 1. Experience as a coach with the National Team in an international competition or training camp
- 2. Personal coach of an athlete on the National Team within the last year
- 3. Curent NCCP certification level

5. COMMUNICATION

Boxing Canada will publish the selection process for coaching staff through Boxing Canada's established channels, including but not limited to the Boxing Canada website and social media platforms.

6. PROCESS AND TIMELINE

Coaches have until Wednesday, January 10, 2024, at 16:00 Eastern time to submit by emailing Boxing Canada's High Performance Director Kraig Devlin at kdevlin@boxingcanada.org. On January 12th, 2024, Boxing Canada will email all selected and non-selected coaches to advise them of the selection decisions.

Only coaches meeting eligibility requirements will be reviewed.

7. FUNDING

Boxing Canada will cover travel and full board accommodation expenses associated with participation in the competition. Please note that this position will not be remunerated.
